Role of Hemodialysis Nurses in the Community

1. Patient Education and Self-Management Support
Hemodialysis patients require a lot of attention in their daily lives, such as diet, medication, and vascular access management. Nurses provide education on these matters to help patients manage their own health.
2. Providing Psychosocial Support
Patients may experience psychological stress and social isolation due to long-term dialysis treatment. Nurses provide regular counseling and support to promote psychological stability in patients and help them form smooth relationships with fellow patients.
3. Multidisciplinary collaboration
Hemodialysis nurses collaborate with various professionals such as doctors, nutritionists, and social workers to provide comprehensive medical services to patients. Through this, they effectively manage patients' complex health problems.
4. Patient safety and quality management
Nurses perform continuous monitoring and quality management activities to prevent complications that may occur during the dialysis process and to respond quickly to emergencies.
5. Community Resource Linkage
In order to strengthen the patient's social support system, additional support services are provided through linkage with community health and welfare organizations. Ex) Hospital accompaniment service, application for long-term care for the elderly, etc.

Dialysis nurses in the community play a key role in improving the overall health and quality of life of dialysis patients.
