Genetic Testing in CKD: Who to Test, When, and How to Act

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Over 600 monogenic or chromosomal structural abnormalities have been identified as underlying chronic kidney diseases. Genetic diagnostic rate is higher in pediatric or young adult patients with chronic kidney disease than in old adult patients. However, as the diagnostic technologies advance rapidly such as long-read genome sequencing, its use is growing both in pediatric and adult patients with chronic kidney disease. This talk will cover recent developments in genome testing for chronic kidney disease.
